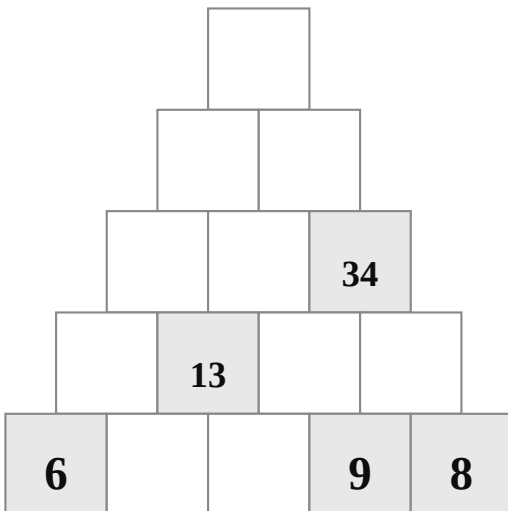

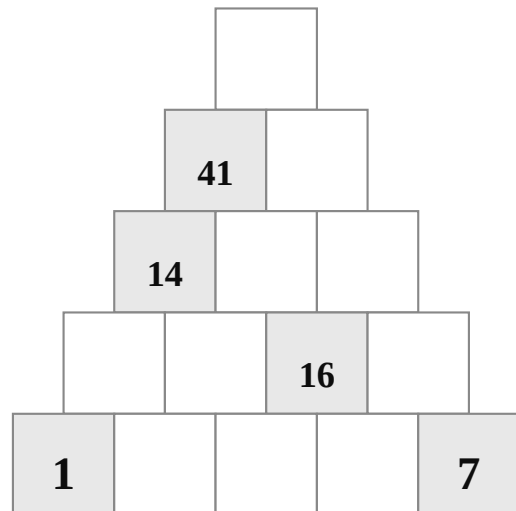
**Pyramid 2 — Medium**
