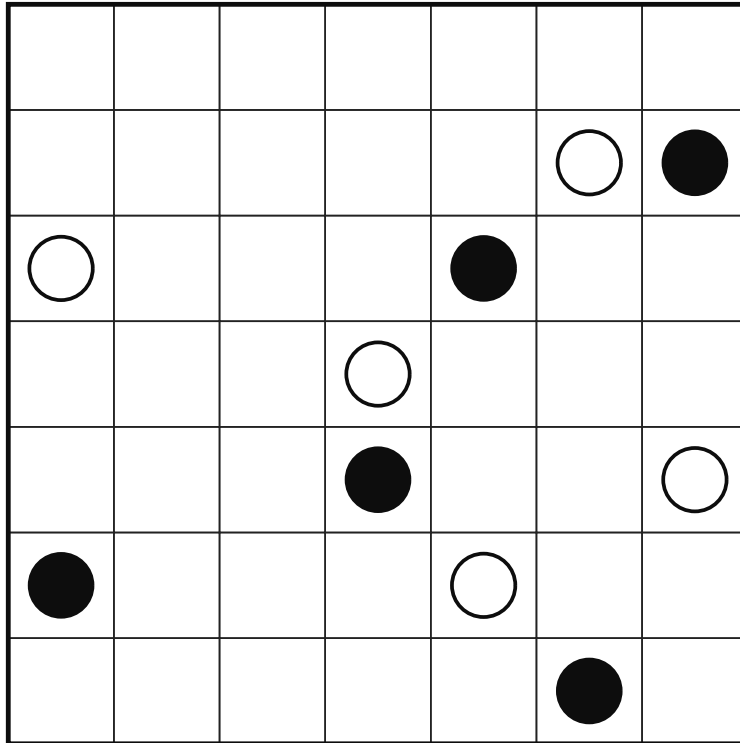
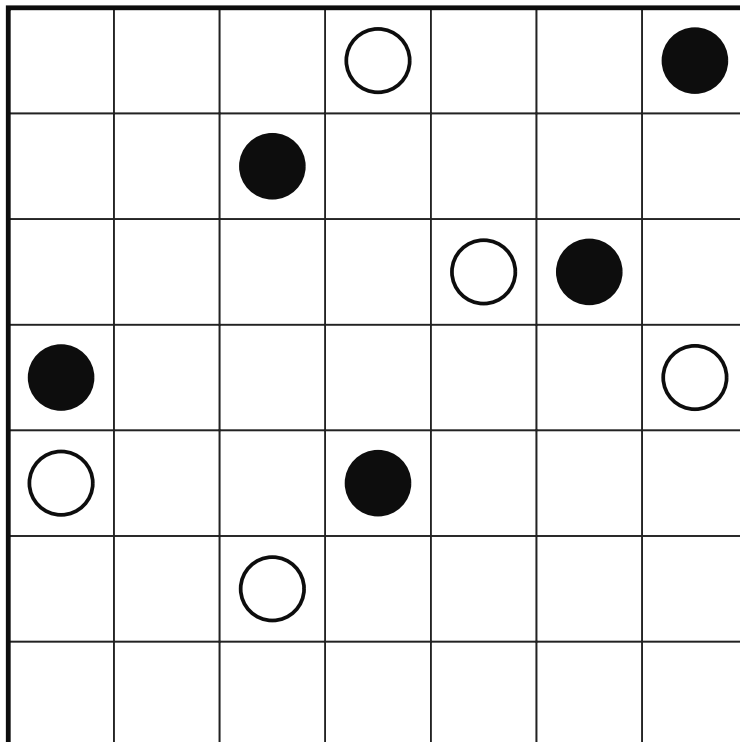


Add pawns so that every row and every column holds exactly one black pawn and one white pawn, and two pawns of the same color never touch diagonally. Add 4 pawns to each board.

Board 1: Medium**Board 2: Medium**

Each outlined region is filled with the numbers 1 up to the number of cells it holds. A three-cell region uses 1, 2, 3; a four-cell region uses 1 to 4; a five-cell region uses 1 to 5. The same number never appears in touching cells, not even diagonally.

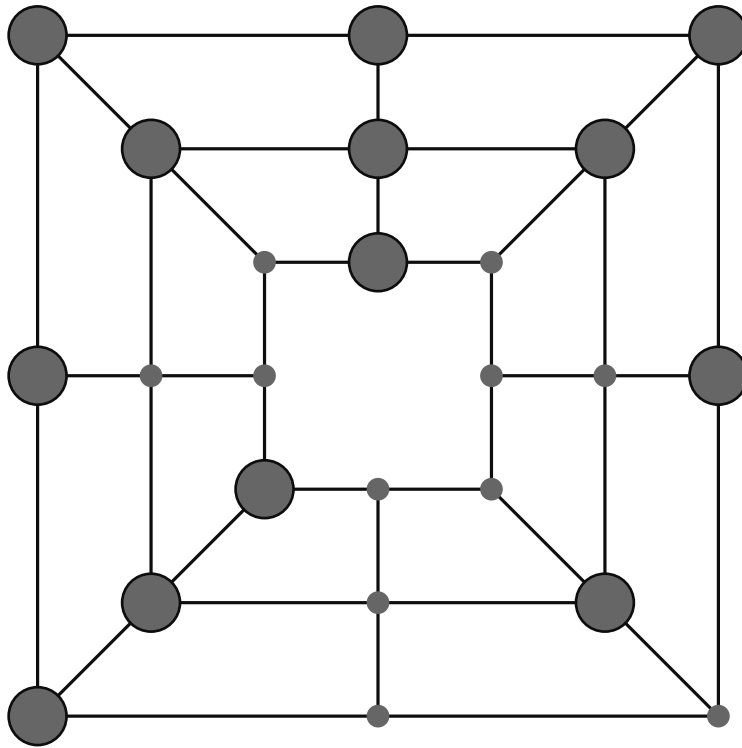

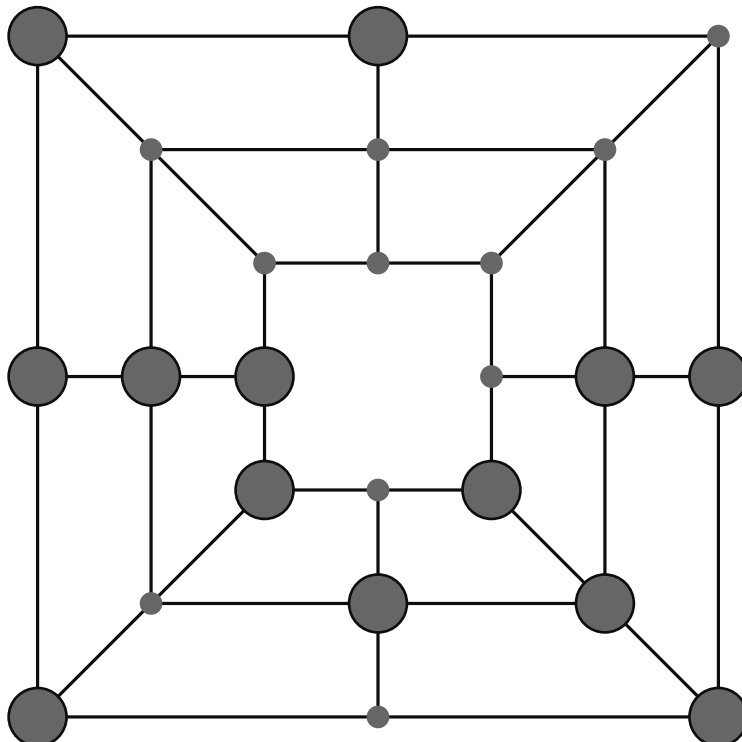

Round 1: Medium - finish with 8 lines of three

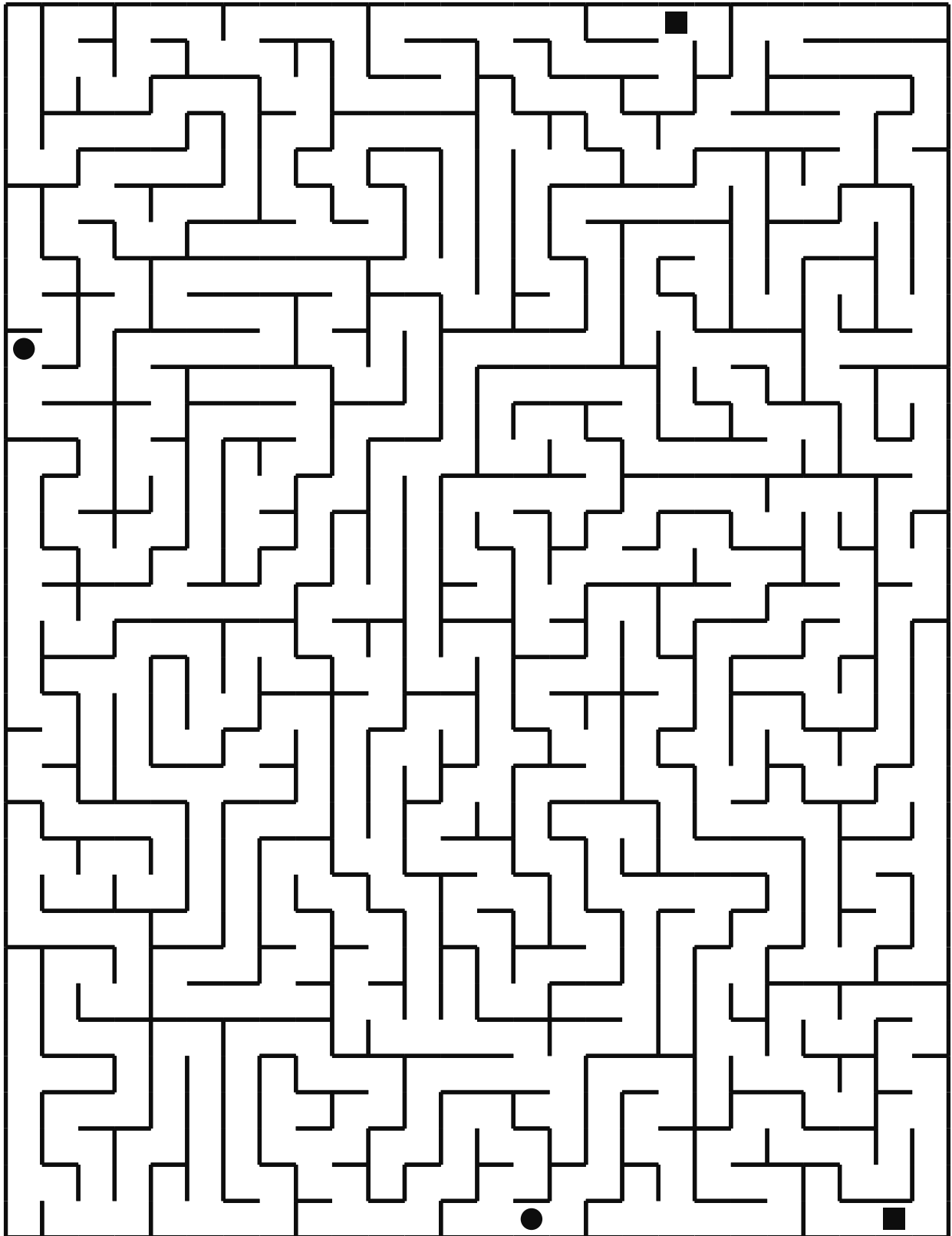


Round 2: Medium - finish with 7 lines of three



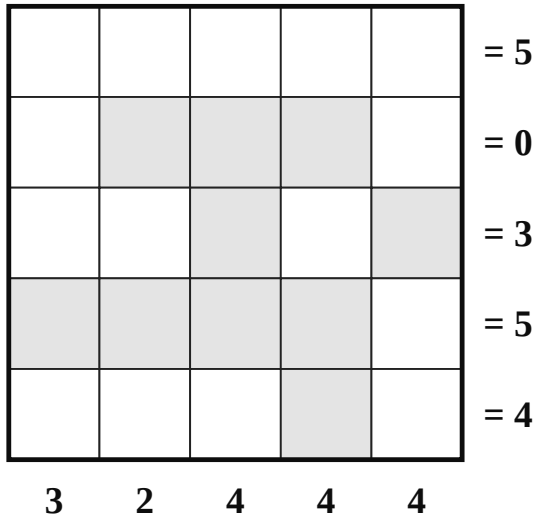
Puzzle: Medium

Two trails share this maze. Draw one path connecting the two CIRCLES, and a second path connecting the two SQUARES. The two paths must never cross or share a corridor.

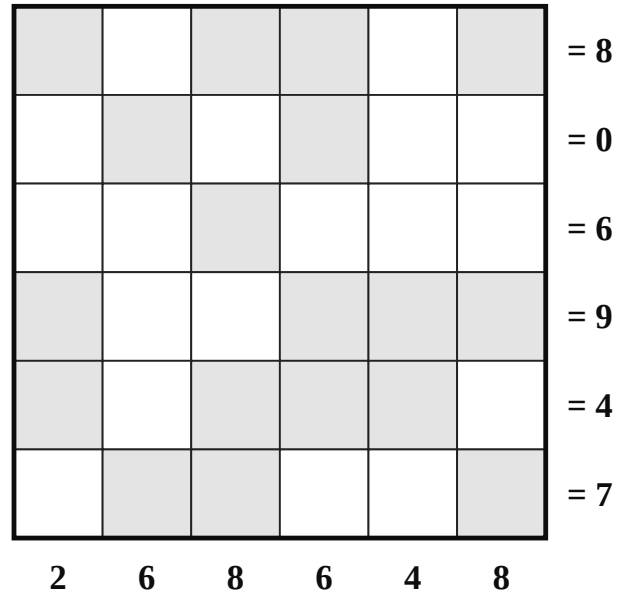


Fill every square with a number: white squares take 0 or 1, shaded squares take 0 or 2. The numbers in each row must add up to the total on its right, and each column to the total below it.

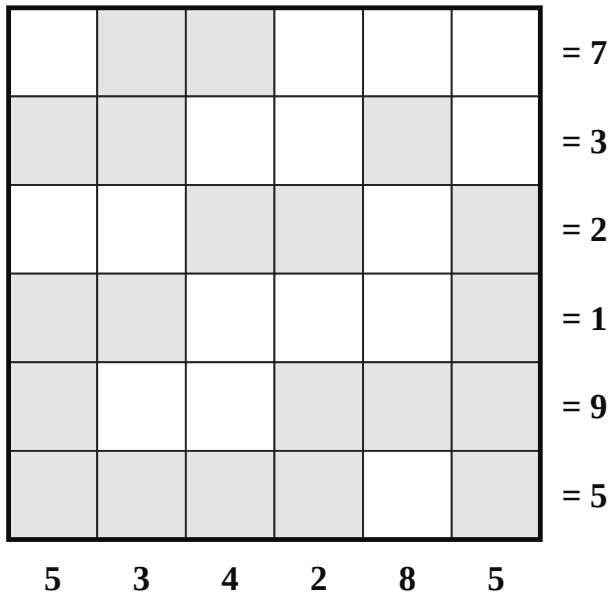

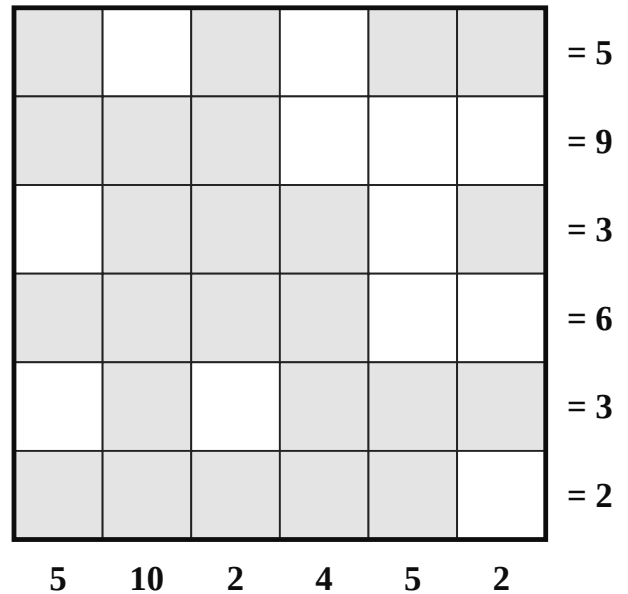

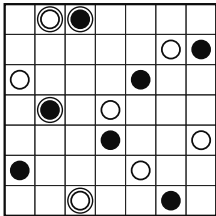

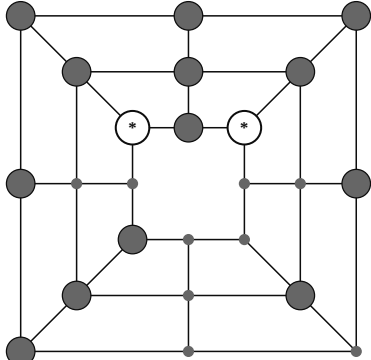

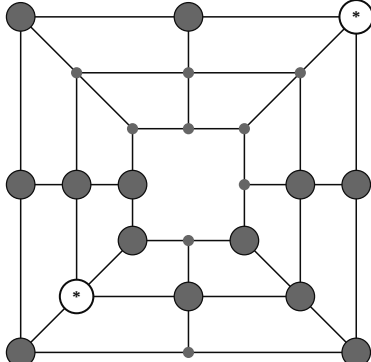

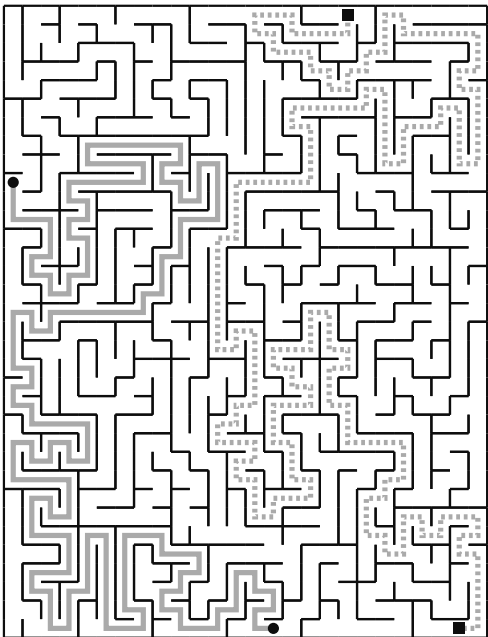
